

Panorama Antennas WEEE Compliance Statement

Collection and Recycling Arrangements in the United Kingdom

Under the UK Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations, for old equipment that you have bought before August 2005 which is being replaced on a one-for-one, like-for-like basis by the purchase of new Panorama Antennas equipment, Panorama Antennas is required to provide arrangements for the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of the old equipment. The old equipment that your new purchase from Panorama Antennas replaces is referred to as Historic WEEE.

Under the UK WEEE Regulations, Panorama Antennas is also required to provide arrangements for the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of any new electrical and electronic equipment that you buy from Panorama Antennas after August 2005, when that new equipment eventually becomes waste. This is referred to as New WEEE.

Panorama Antennas products are very competitively priced. Any new increase in operating costs for manufacturers such as Panorama Antennas is normally reflected in a price increase in the product. However, instead of increasing the prices of our products, Panorama Antennas has decided to share these new environmental costs directly with our customers. We believe in being transparent with you on any new environmental costs that our products need to address.

Our approach to sharing these new environmental costs is:

- Panorama Antennas pays for the costs of treatment and recycling of the WEEE to meet the targets set by the WEEE Regulations;
- Panorama Antennas pays for the costs of data management and reporting to the Environment Agency to demonstrate compliance with all administrative requirements of the WEEE Regulations;
- you pay for transportation of your WEEE to Panorama Antennas in the UK.

All New WEEE that arises from the purchase of Panorama Antennas products is classed as non-hazardous waste.

By purchasing from Panorama Antennas you agree that it is your responsibility to arrange and pay for costs of collection and transportation to Panorama Antennas. In order to meet UK Duty of Care Regulations for waste disposal, you should use one of the following carriers (which hold a valid Waste Carriers licence):

To comply with the UK Duty of Care Regulations the transport of your waste to Panorama Antennas must be accompanied by suitable documentation. You must also keep a signed copy of this documentation for two years.
